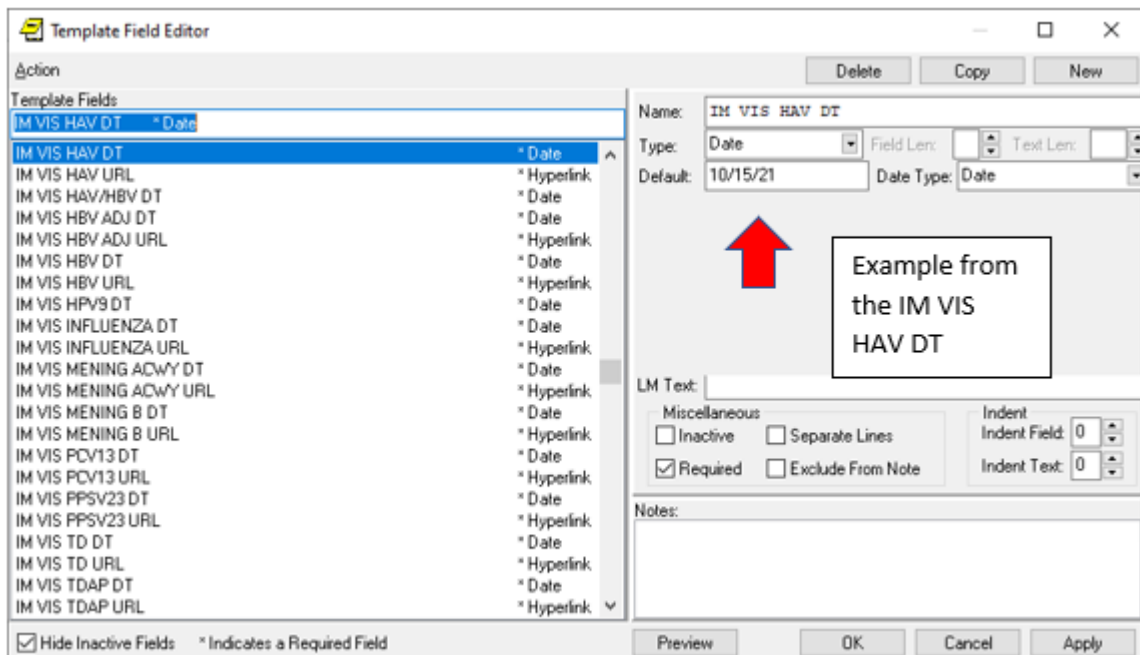

Reminder Resolution: Mammogram Screening

The ACS and VHA recommends:

- Women with an average risk for breast cancer undergo regular screening mammography starting at age 45 years.
- Women aged 45 to 54 years old should be screened annually.
- Women 55 years and older should transition to biennial screening or have the opportunity to continue screening annually.
- Women should have the opportunity to begin annual screening between the ages of 40 and 44 years.
- Women should continue screening mammography as long as their overall health is good and they have a life expectancy of 10 years or longer.
