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## Introduction

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The updates contained in this release are based upon feedback provided from the field. Updates are included for the following reminder dialogs:

- VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION
- VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG SHIFT ASSESSMENT
- VA-AES NURSING IV INSERTION AND MAINTENANCE

The primary focus of this release is to enhance functionality within the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION dialog. However, two updates to the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG SHIFT ASSESSMENT were added to this release and are as follows:

- Updates to the branching logic for NEWS to contain the updated VA-VAAES AVPU health factors.
- Peripheral IV #2 health summary object updated to display the correct gauge information. This issue will also be corrected within the VA-AES NURSING IV INSERTION AND MAINTENANCE dialog.

The major enhancements to the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION are as follows:

- Added the Morse Fall Scale & TIPS, Aspiration Assessment and Swallow Screen, and Pain Assessment sections from the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG SHIFT ASSESSMENT
- Added new content sections: Risk of Wandering; Sexual Health
- General Information-Under Acute Rehab Section:
  - Updated options under ABILITY TO AMBULATE PRIOR TO ADMISSION and added corresponding HFs:
    - Removed Ambulatory – Independent and replaced with Independent
    - Removed Partial Assistance and replaced with Minimum Assist
    - Added Moderate Assist
    - Removed Total Assistance and replaced with Total Assist
- Under Infectious Disease:
  - Removed COVID-19 Screen and replaced with new Travel Screen Section
  - MDRO - added “other” option with text box.
  - Added button to display local MDRO Patient Record Flag notes (if applicable)
  - Added National Carbapenem-resistant Enterobacteriaceae (CRE) content. PLEASE NOTE: this content is disabled on install. Sites can enable and disable as needed. ***Communication with local Infection Control and Prevention committee is needed***
  - MRSA Swabbing – Added check box in front of MRSA Swabbing which allows users to bypass this content if they are not currently swabbing for MRSA.
  - MRSA Swab Not obtained – Added text box.
  - MRSA Swab Obtained prior to Admission – Added location text box
  - Added Enhanced Barrier (for CLC) as an option under Isolation type and added this precaution type to the reference table.
  - Isolation types - Changed Protective to Protective Environment

- Reference Table – added text “Loss of Taste or smell may prompt for COVID was added to the symptoms column.
- Morse Fall Risk automatically selects the correct scoring option
- Under Audit C Screen:
  - AUDIT C automatically selects the correct scoring option
  - Positive Alcohol Screen education updated to match national content.
  - Added 8 or more as a scoring option
  - Removed option for “later during hospitalization”
  - added comment box for time of last consumption (requested by field)
  - Changed question from “Have you drank alcohol...” to “Have you consumed alcohol
- Under Tobacco/Nicotine:
  - Updated Tobacco/Nicotine Screen question to meet performance measures to take effect January 2021.
  - Under Complete Tobacco Cessation Education added local option to refer to Tobacco Cessation Team.
  - Added option “To be completed by provider”
- Under the Suicide Screen:
  - Removed the PHQ-9 question
  - Corrected the C-SSRS results to show in the chart output if it was completed within 24 hours of admission
- Under Medication Review, added content to document disposition of medications brought from home.
- Corrected health summary object to display admission date/time for passcode.
- Under Nutrition Screen
  - Revision with branching logic - amount of weight lost only needs to be addressed if answered “Yes” to Lost weight without trying
  - Removed “unsure” to decreased appetite
- Added two unique elements for consulting Social worker for advance directives and for consult social worker for discharge planning to accommodate sites with specific consults for these services.
- Updated the section headers in final progress note test to easily identify sections.

The purpose of the national templates is to preserve the ability to collect pertinent data for quality-driven healthcare. A yearly review will be conducted by the Office of Nursing Informatics and the Office of Nursing Service to optimize core content and bring new evidence-based knowledge to our clinicians at point of care.

**The template and Health Factors may not be changed or revised at the local level** except for local elements identified in post-install instructions. Requests to add elements to the note must go through the approval process outlined in the REDACTED.




