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Introduction

This release contains updates to the reminder dialog VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION SCREEN.

It also includes a new reminder dialog **VAAES MENTAL HEALTH NSG ADMISSION SCREEN**.

1. VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION SCREEN:
REMINDER: VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION SCREEN templates are mandated for use.

The primary focus of this release is to enhance functionality within the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION SCREEN.

Since the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION SCREEN shares groups and elements that are within the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG SHIFT ASSESSMENT and VA-AES NSG FREQUENT DOCUMENTATION, updates to shared data elements will update both templates (See enhancements list below).

The major enhancements to the VA-AES ACUTE INPATIENT NSG ADMISSION are as follows:

UNABLE TO OBTAIN ASSESSMENT AT THIS TIME:

- Updated header to all CAPS.
- Added text instructions under the UNABLE TO OBTAIN ADMISSION SCREENING AT THIS TIME, visible on template to staff AND instructions to display in the progress note: ++ This includes all components of the assessment including screenings. ++
- Updated options to:
 - Patient medically/cognitively unstable: Specify: Text box (required field)
 - Patient behaviorally unstable: Specify: Text box (required field)
 - Removed Other as an option.
- Added reference text for examples of Medically/Cognitive/Behaviorally Unstable.

ALLERGY/ADVERSE DRUG REACTION (ADR) REVIEW:

- Under Allergy/Adverse Drug Reaction Review to be conducted by: Removed Pharmacy Tech/Pharmacist.
- Updated Send consult/notification to pharmacy to Click here for Consult/notification to Pharmacy under Nurse Review.

MEDICATION REVIEW:

- Under Medication to be conducted by: Removed Pharmacy Tech and Pharmacist.
- Added reference text ++ For Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Program (RRTP) do not complete medication review below. Please use your facility safe medication management assessment per local policy ++
- Updated Consult placed to pharmacy to Click here for Consult/notification to Pharmacy under Nurse Review.
- Added health factors to Did patient bring medication(s) from home for the Yes and No responses.
- Added health factor to Additional Comments under Nurse Conduct Medication Review.

- Under Preferred language for discussing healthcare: Spanish, Sign Language and Other: Updated Click here to order Social Work Consult to Click here for consult/notification to Social Work.
- Removed Need for interpretation under Preferred language for discussing healthcare: Spanish.
- Changed header Sensory Deficits to Sensory Deficits & Contributing Information.
- Under Sensory Deficits and Contributing Information, Hearing and Visual deficits, changed selections to Bilateral, Right Only and Left Only.
- Under Rehab Items at bedside, Hearing Aids, changed selections to Bilateral, Right Only and Left Only.
- Removed all caps on Ability to Ambulate Prior to Admission: Updated selections to correspond with Level of Assistance References in the VAAES Acute Inpatient NSG Shift Assessment; Added a button for ADL Level of Assistance Reference; added health factors to Ambulatory – Equipment/Devices; Non-Ambulatory – Bedrest; Non-Ambulatory – Manual Wheelchair; Non-Ambulatory – Power Wheelchair.
- Updated Items at Bedside to include items withheld and changed glasses/contacts element to visual aids, updated hearing aids to Bilateral, Right Only, and Left Only.

INFECTIOUS DISEASE:

- Placed (*) beside the required fields for first two travel questions.

- Made Within the last 14 days, have you had: and Other Exposure to Infectious Disease: required fields (*).
- Alphabetized Patient reported the following symptoms and added an (*) for required field.
- Updated Abdominal to Abdominal pain (stomach)
- Added (light sensitivity) to Photophobia.
- Under History of Multiple Drug Resistant Organism (MDRO); Do you know, or have you ever been told that you have an antibiotic resistant germ or organism; Yes; MDRO Type: updated Carbapenem-resistant Enterobacteriaceae to Carbapenem-resistant Enterobacterales species.
- Updated Carbapenem-resistant Enterobacteriaceae header to Carbapenem-resistant Enterobacterales. Added health factors to Click here to order CRE Swab; Provider or designated team member notified (name): and Comments.
- Redesigned the Collect MRSA Swab by changing the Collect MRSA Swab section. Removed the Yes/No responses. Added health factor for Click to place order for MRSA Swab. Added a text box to MRSA Swab obtained prior to admission.
- Added health factor to Infection Prevention and Control Specialist notified.

NUTRITION SCREENING:

- Added (Previous 6 months) to the Weight Health Summary Object; changed HSO to look back 6 months.
- Added (*) to required questions: Lost weight recently without trying and have you been eating poorly because of decreased appetite.
- Added health factor to Malnutrition Screening Total Score.
- Under Lost weight recently without trying removed option for Less than 1 kg (2 lbs.) (0 points)
- Updated lbs./kgs on each selection of Amount weight lost.
- Changed reference text to ++ This is a scored tool. A score of greater than or equal to 2 requires a Consult/notification to Registered Dietitian for positive nursing nutrition admission screen.
++
- Changed Eating poorly due to decreased appetite to Have you been eating poorly because of decreased appetite?
- Changed Additional Nutrition Screening to Other Nutrition Screening Questions; removed Patient requiring tube feedings/TPN/PPN; and added new questions. Updated reference text to ++ If the patient answered YES to any of the above questions OR has a score of 2 or greater for the Malnutrition Screening, Consult/notify a Registered Dietitian. Updated Consult to Click here for Consult/notification to Registered Dietitian.

- Added health factor to Do you have any food allergies, intolerance, special dietary needs, or ethnic, cultural, or religious preferences affecting your dietary needs?
- Added Food Insecurity Screening questions and Disposition.

RISK SCREENS

- Added Complete to AUD-C.
- Added an (*) to Perform AUDC button for required item.
- Under Audit C Score, added Patient declines to answer AUDIT-C.
- Under Complete alcohol education/intervention: Audit C Score 5 to 7 and 8 or more, updated Now to Now by nurse.
- Under AUDIT-C score 5 to 7: Complete alcohol education/intervention: ETOH Education; Now by Nurse: added May to Offer Services for Alcohol Misuse; updated Other option to Other services offered; added option for Current admission for RRTP with health factor; updated Consult to Click here to order Consult/notification for ETOH Intervention.
- Under AUDIT-C score of 8 or more: Complete alcohol education/intervention: ETOH Education; Now by Nurse: added Must to Offer Alcohol Misuse Services; updated Other option to Other services offered; added option for Current admission for RRTP with health factor; updated Consult to Click here to order Consult/notification for ETOH Intervention.
- Changed Have you consumed alcohol within the last 72 hours to Does the patient consume alcohol? Added * identifying this element is required.
- Changed Volume/Quantity to Amount used/Frequency. Added health factors to Yes and No selections.
- Updated TOBACCO/NICOTINE to TOBACCO USE.
- Changed Do you currently or have you ever used tobacco or nicotine products to Do you currently or have you ever used tobacco products?
- If yes selected to current tobacco use, moved E-Cigarettes/Vaping to a new section.
- Moved reference text under Tobacco Use; Yes: to a new section: ** Evidence Based Practice (EBP) does not currently support the use of Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT) for electronic nicotine delivery systems. **
- Added health factors to Yes - Current tobacco user options: Cigarettes, Smokeless and Cigars/Pipes. Removed Type and text box.
- Under TOBACCO USE: Changed The patient was not screened for tobacco use because of cognitive impairment to Patient unable to answer and added a health factor.
- Added new section for Do you currently or have you ever used alternative nicotine products? Yes: Nicotine gum, Nicotine patches,

Chew pouches, E-cigarettes/vaping, and No with health factors. Added reference text ++ Evidence Based Practice (EBP) does not currently support the use of Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT) for alternative nicotine products. ++

- Under Complete tobacco cessation education: updated Now to Now by nurse. Updated Referred to tobacco cessation team to Click here to Consult/notification to Tobacco Cessation Team.
- Under Complete tobacco cessation education: Now by Nurse: Complete counseling: Patient understanding of tobacco cessation counseling: updated Referred to tobacco cessation team to Click here for Consult/notification to Tobacco Cessation Team.
- Added health factors to all items under Patient understanding of tobacco cessation counseling.
- Updated selections under patient understanding. Verbalizes understanding; Needs further reinforcement and/or counseling/teaching; Needs potential supervision for adherence to smoke free environment due to medical or cognitive status
- Updated Substance Use Assessment: Changed Have you used any recreational drugs or narcotics in the last 72 hours to Do you use any recreational drugs or narcotics (prescription or non-prescription), added * to indicate this is required; Yes: Added Amount used/Frequency to each selection with Date/Time of last use. Added health factors to Yes and No selections.
- Updated Substance Use Disorder Provider Notification to: Discussed with provider any other concerns related to substance use disorder(s) or risk for withdrawal: Free text field.
- Added additional descriptors to each Substance Use Assessment items: Added Marijuana to Cannabinoids; Added Synthetics to Hallucinogens with mushrooms and K2 as examples.
- Added Offer Services for Substance Use Disorder with health factors.

RISK OF WANDERING:

- Separated Wandering and Elopement questions; added new health factors.
- Added (Excludes Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Program [RRTP]) to history of wandering.
- Added health factor to Is the patient expressing a desire/plan to leave immediately? No selection.
- Added health factor to Comment selection.
- Added reference text ++ Other risk factors include: positive risk screens (C-SSRS, alcohol or substance withdrawal) and/or acute or chronic diagnosis that affects cognition. If any of these present, complete Neurological Assessment and Environmental Safety Interventions as appropriate ++.

SUICIDE SCREEN:

- If C-SSRS is completed in the ED or on admission with positive results, the Positive selection will auto select.
- Changed Health Summary Object for completion of C-SSRS to look back 24 hours from admission time. Previously looked back 24 hours from time of note.
- Under C-SSRS Screen: Positive: added a health summary object to pull in the last CSRE result within the past year. Previously, selections were not available if C-SSRS was completed in the ED for positive; selections are now available; removed Warm handoff to: and changed to Has CSRE been completed within 24 hours of a positive C-SSRS? Yes/No selections with health factors.
- If No: added reference text ++ Notify Provider and Designated Health Care Team Member for warm handoff and need for CSRE evaluation. ++ and Person contacted: Free text box; Changed wording on last option to Environmental risk check complete, hazardous items checked and removed from patient and room.

EXPOSURE TO VIOLENCE AND ABUSE RISK PRE-SCREEN:

- Updated reference text ++ If patient answered 'YES' to either of the above, order consult/notify Social Work.
- Updated Consult to Click here for Consult/notification to Social Work.

POST TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER (PTSD) CARE CONSIDERATIONS:

- Spelled PTSD out in header.
- Removed Military Sexual Trauma (MST) Care Considerations from header and questions. Separated into own header.
- Updated health factor on PTSD Screening.

MILITARY SEXUAL TRAUMA (MST) CARE CONSIDERATIONS:

- New header created for MST.
- New health factor on MST Screening.

REPRODUCTIVE/SEXUAL HEALTH:

- Updated header to Reproductive/Sexual Health with new health factor.
- Only question appearing for male patients and changed wording to Do you have any sexual or reproductive concerns you would like your healthcare team to be aware of? With Yes/No selections.
- Reproductive questions only appear for female patients.
- Changed Are you pregnant or is there a possibility you are pregnant to Pregnancy Status: Patient denies; Possible unconfirmed; Confirmed positive and Last Menstrual Period with Date field.

- Updated consults to Pharmacy and Nutrition to Click here to consult/notify Pharmacy and Nutrition.

ADVANCED DIRECTIVE NOTIFICATION/SCREENING:

- Updated consult to Click here for consult/notification to Social Work
- Added Care to the National Center for Ethics in Health hyperlink.
- Added (*) to required questions This education can also be assessed at National Center for Ethics in Healthcare and The patient wishes to receive information about or assistance with Advance Care Planning and/or Advance Directive.

SPIRITUALITY

- Updated header to Spirituality
- Added health factor to No selection.
- Updated consult to Click here for Consult/notification to Chaplain.

ANTICIPATED DISCHARGE:

- Moved Do you have a legal guardian/Conservator to the General Information section.
- Added free text boxes under all selections under Where do you live and Method of Transportation upon discharge.
- Added to Where do you live options for Residential facility/group home: Free text box with new health factor; Unable to obtain: Free text box with new health factor; updated health factor on Other selection.
- Added to Method of Transportation options for VA Transport: Free text box with new health factor; updated health factor on Other selection. Changed order of options.
- Added upon discharge after Method of transportation.
- Updated all consults under Where do you live to Click here for Consult/notification to Social Work.
- Updated all consults under Method of transportation upon discharge to Click here for Consult/notification to Social Work.
- Added a section for “Are there any anticipated barriers to discharge.”

EDUCATION NEEDS/LEARNING STYLE:

- Changed order of patient learning style preference and added 1:1 and Group as options.

2. VAAES MENTAL HEALTH NSG ADMISSION SCREEN V1.0

In 2020 the Office of Nursing Services (ONS) and the Office of Nursing informatics (ONI) developed the VA Approved Enterprise Standard (VAAES) Acute Inpatient NSG Admission Screen note template to create a seamless, standardized nursing admission screening note within all inpatient acute settings (Med-Surg, Telemetry, Intermediate, and Intensive Care, Acute Rehabilitation). A corresponding Standard Operating Procedure is in place to guide nursing practice. Once the initial VAAES product went through vigorous pilot testing, and revisions were made, the Mental Health and Residential Rehab Treatment Program (RRTP) were included.

The content of the VAAES Mental Health NSG Admission Screen is based on a compilation of content developed by the ONS Mental Health Field Advisory Committee, Cerner content, and Acute Care Delivery (ACD) Essential Data Set (EDS) that was developed and implemented in 2020.

All content was vetted across multiple consulting stakeholders and program offices including Office of Nursing Services, Office of Nursing Informatics, and the Office of Mental Health and Suicide Prevention, Quality/EPRP/IPEC, and National Center of Patient Safety.

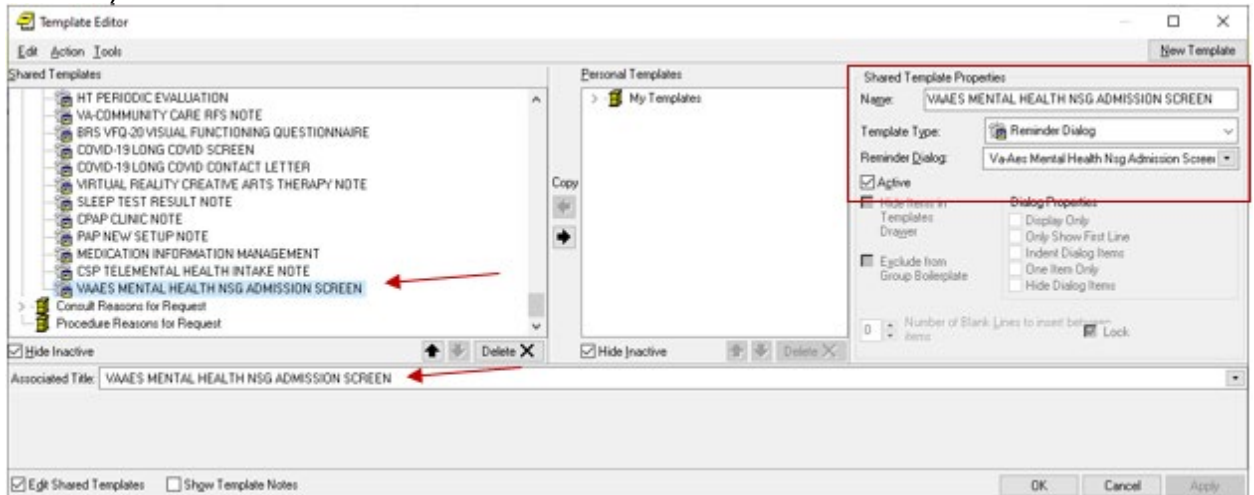
