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## **Introduction**

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This new template ensures documentation of the provision of syringe services, including for syringes provided with and without a prescription (e.g., pharmacy and logistics, respectively).

There is a proposed National Directive supporting these efforts that is going through the national concurrence process.

This note has been approved by the National Harm Reduction Support & Development Workgroup and circulated widely with key SMEs and program offices.



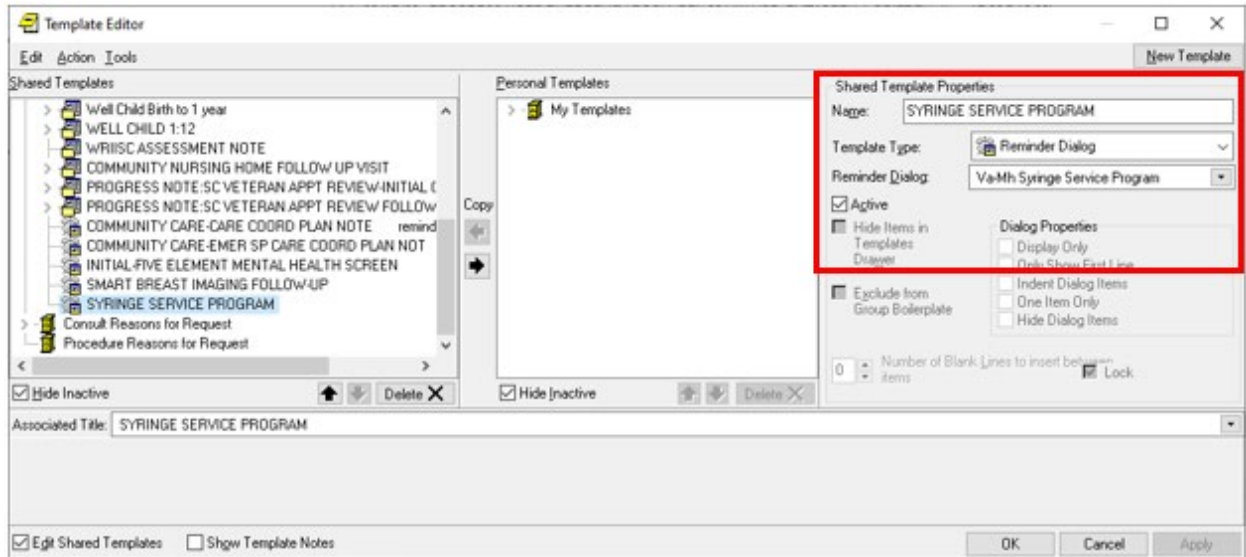

2. VAL-SPP ADDITIONAL ORDER CONDOMS - add your local order for condoms orders as an additional finding.
3. VAL-SPP ADDITIONAL ORDER HEPA- add your local order for a hepatitis A vaccination orders as an additional finding.
4. VAL-SPP ADDITIONAL ORDER HEPB - add your local order for a hepatitis B vaccination orders as an additional finding.
5. VAL-SPP ADDITIONAL ORDER PREP – Add your local order for Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) to prevent HIV infection as an additional finding.
6. VAL-SPP ADDITIONAL ORDER TOB MEDS – Add your local order or menu for tobacco cessation medications as an additional finding.
