<p>1. HBPC package is not multidivisional. All locations will need to agree on the application start-up parameters and coordinate the use of the application. Transmission option will transmit for all divisions.</p> <p>This application has its own transmitting facility that will need to set-up the new site number on their system. Contact person will be provided.</p>			
<p>2. System Parameters Edit – Located in the Manager Menu</p> <p>A. Number of Visit Days to Scan</p> <p>B. Transmit Report Printer</p>			
<p>3. Populate the HBHC Valid State Code file (#631.8) via FileMan</p> <p>States that are to be included in the HBPC program for this site should be entered.</p>			
<p>4. Populate the following files using the options found on the HBHC Manager Menu:</p> <p>A. Team File (#633)</p>			Requires HBHC MANAGER key

Provider File (#631.4)</p> <p>1) Provider number</p> <p>(a) This field represents a unique 4 numeric digit HBPC provider number assigned to each person who has any FTEE charged to HBPC.</p> <p>(b) The 4 digit number should be structured as follows:</p> <p>(a) 1st digit : 1 for nonstudents, 2 for students</p>			

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<p>(b) 2nd digit: 0 thru 8 indicating discipline: (i) 0 RN (ii) 1 LPN, LVN, Home Health Aide or Tech, Nursing Assistant (iii) 2 Social Worker (iv) 3 OT, PT, CT, Rehabilitation Therapist (v) 4 Dietitian, Nutritionist (vi) 5 Physician (vii) 6 Nurse Practitioner (viii) 7 Clinical Pharmacist (ix) 8 Other</p> <p>(c) 3rd and 4th digits contain 0 thru 99 indicating individual provider as follows: (i) 0 first staff member in discipline (ii) 1 second staff member in discipline (iii) 2 third staff member in discipline, etc. (iv) All students in a particular discipline should share the same HBPC provider number (e.g. All RN students would be 200). (v) Provider number '190' can be used as a 'catch-all' category if the need arises.</p> <p>2) It is required that all providers for the program be assigned to a team. 3) Once the provider file is completed, run the HBPC Provider File Report option. Check for accuracy.</p>			
<p>C. Clinic File (#631.6) 1) All clinics assigned to HBPC need to be entered</p>			<p>Once an entry is added in 631.6, it cannot be deleted.</p>
